The St John First Aid in Schools Program is a program designed to deliver free First Aid training in schools.

The program has four (4) modules across primary and secondary school. The First Aid learning is age appropriate and integrates with the South Australian Curriculum, Standards and Accountability Framework (SACSA) which is the curriculum used in government schools for Reception to Year 10.

As a Program Volunteer you will visit schools throughout Adelaide and empower students with First Aid skills so they are ready to save a life in the event of an emergency.

These volunteer positions would suit individuals who possess good verbal and written skills, have the ability to provide training to students and have a knowledge of training concepts and First Aid.

Successful candidates will be required to hold a current National Police Certificate (NPC) no older than 3 months, prior to commencement of volunteering with St John.

Successful candidates will also be required to undertake Child Safe Environments (formerly Mandated Notification) training.

This is a fantastic opportunity to showcase and use your skills and abilities whilst making a difference to school students within the South Australian community.
